## Estimated level of sexual abuse by Catholic clergy by the estimated level of paedophile priests

The following figures reflect the estimated percentage of paedophile priest using public sources, such as Pope Francis to expert reports, to qualify those figures

- 1. Various sources have claimed that the percentage of religious priests who are paedophiles is roughly:
  - a. 2% as claimed by Pope Francis (interview with Eugenio Scalfari [π <a href="https://bit.ly/1m6Uy55">https://bit.ly/201u6Vs</a>]) in keeping with Dr. Richard Sipe in 1990, John Jay Report at <a href="http://bit.ly/LOJiBb">https://bit.ly/LOJiBb</a> page 216.
  - b. 4% as claimed by Bryan T. Froehle in 1997, John Jay Report at <a href="http://bit.ly/LOJiBb">http://bit.ly/LOJiBb</a> page 27.
  - c. 6% as claimed by Spotlight in keeping with Dr. Richard Sipe references made in the film where 90 priests are the estimate from a population of 1,500
  - d. 7% as claimed by Australian Royal Commission <a href="http://jrnl.ie/3224627">http://jrnl.ie/3224627</a> Report based on allegation between 1950 and 2010.
  - e. Variations on the percentage are also noted where NSAC claim Boston actually has 8.9% of the Catholic religious are paedophiles

What is clearly shown by these figures for sexual abuse of Catholic minors is that Italy as a country has the potential to exceed the reported number of victims of clerical child sexual abuse to that in other countries worldwide. A government inquiry is essential in Italy in order to get at the truth providing pathways to justice and support to address the scandal of clerical child sexual abuse.

The scale of abuse in Italy has the potential to be the greatest of any country. I have no idea what figures you have on how many survivors of clerical child sexual abuse have come forward in Italy. I have done the following research based on current statistics on the catholic population and the total number of priests in Italy at this time. Depending on the percentage of priests considered to be paedophiles, 2%, 4%, 6%, etc I was able to estimate the number of paedophile priests in Italy according to that percentage. I then multiplied the number of paedophile priests by the estimated number of victims per paedophile priest to estimate the number of survivors. If only 10% of survivors came forward in Italy where 7% of Italian priests were paedophiles, the same proportion as Australia, there would be anything from 17,500 to 87,700 reported survivors of clerical child sexual abuse. Currently the total number of reported survivors in Ireland and the United States is 18,500, or 4,444 survivors in Australia, or 3,677 in Germany with many more to be included yet. The scale of the reported survivors is increasing as more people find the strength and courage to come forward.

The following data provides estimates from varying percentage rates of priests who might be paedophiles at this time. The resultant figures representing the estimated number of paedophile priests in a number of different countries are then multiplied by the estimated number of victims per paedophile priest. From this we can estimate the total number of unreported victims. Some experts believe that only 10% of victims come forward. It is easy from the following table to estimate the expected numbers of victims who may have reported their abuse in countries like Italy where there has been no governmental inquiry into clerical child sexual abuse.
